


# OSAC SUPPORTING COMMUNITY MISSIONS




The Xchange Centre continues to work towards its mission to resource our community in the practical love of Jesus by equipping the church to love people, share Jesus and make disciples. Through COVID we've been able to continue to offer our financial, relationship and discipleship services online. The pandemic has certainly impacted these three areas, created new conversations and it is my hope that Jesus increasingly uses our church partnerships and services to offer Owen Sound the hope and love of Jesus.

It has been exciting to see many take part in online Alpha, CAP Money Course and Family Life Canada relationship coaching. I am especially grateful for the partnership of Owen Sound Alliance church in offering these services. As you look ahead and embark on your new adventure: new grade, new school, new program, new apprenticeship, new format, new 'normal' ... let me offer you four "W" words.


